d'Amico evaluates strengthening their Moroccan fleet

Subsidiary d'Amico Dry Maroc announced 2 containerships will join the fleet by 2018-2019

As announced by subsidiary d'Amico Dry Maroc, while inviting potential interested workers to apply for being recruited on board their ships, d'Amico Società di Navigazione is getting ready to strengthen their Mediterranean fleet.

The company pinpointed they are currently operating 3 units (2,060 TEUs Cielo di Rabat, 951 TEUs Cielo di Casablanca and 1,730 TEUs Cielo di Agadir) but new ones will be deployed by 2018 and 2019.

Gruppo d'Amico headquarter of Rome confirmed that: "our plans on d'Amico Dry Maroc focus on business strengthening and development, also purchasing new ships".

Morocco-based shipping company, supported by Navighreb local shipagent, is primarily engaged in cabotage services calling at several Moroccan ports (Agadir, Tangier Med and Casablanca), while also providing a feeder service to Western Mediterranean shipping hubs (primarily in Italy, France, Spain and Tunisia).

d'Amico Dry Maroc has a long-term relationship with the Moroccan shipping cluster, also confirmed by their cooperation with ISEM which engage its best students as seafarers aboard the company's ships.
