INTERTANKO, a shipping association dedicated to the tanker industry, has elected Paolo d'Amico as its new chairman.

Mr d'Amico, who is managing director of Italy's d'Amico Societá di Navigazione, takes over from Nikolas Tsakos, who had been in the role for four years.

"I am honoured to take over the helm at a time when the association's role in today's challenging environment is more prominent than ever," Mr d'Amico said. "Commercial sustainability of the tanker industry will remain high on our agenda, as will a continued push for operational excellence and environmental protection."

"I look forward to leading Intertanko as it continues to advance the interests of its members in the various legislatorial arenas, not least as we move towards the next big ticket item in the shape of the 2020 sulphur cap," he said.

Mr d'Amico has been vice-chairman of the group since 2012.

Separately, Mr d'Amico has been appointed chief executive of d'Amico International Shipping, the company's tankers unit, following the resignation of Marco Fiori who leaves at the end of the year.
